**A successful coaching weekend was held on Saturday and Sunday attended by 14 men, 9 ladies and 10-15 juniors.** As advertised, our local PGA pro Heath Garvey and visiting PGA Pro from Mount Coolum Golf Club TJ King, conducted clinics for our men, ladies and juniors.

All attendees learned a thing or 2 to improve their game.

Proof was in the pudding with the quality of the coaching as our Sporters President Tunna Hewson played brilliantly a mere couple of hours after his lesson to be narrowly pipped on a count-back for the chocolates on Sunday.

**We thank Golf Australia and the DDGA in helping fund these days to allow our club to offer this for free. Positive outcomes were...**

1. Heath made the comment, in particular after our session with our men, that players would see him for further lessons to improve their games.
2. The eagerness of some of our juniors to back up enthusiastically 2 days in a row.
3. TJ's comments on how good our facilities are in particular our practice areas. Eg Mount Coolum doesn't have the space for a driving range like we have. He also was positive on the state of our greens which is pleasing given where we have come from in the last 12 months.
4. TJ King tearing the course apart on Saturday afternoon with a 7 under 65 that could well have been a 62.
5. Despite that, he was beaten on a count-back for the monthly mug (69 nett).
6. Also, carrying our club manager Gavin Pontin, he wasn't able to win the Keno ticket. Those honours went to opposition Craig Brennan and Charles Maguire, despite Charles's 9 on the 17th.
7. TJ was very appreciative of the local hospitality, in particular the refreshments, before, during and after golf.

### **Range Balls**

Unfortunately, like a lot of things these days practice range balls are very hard to source. Whilst we encourage our members and social players to practice their golf, we do ask that range balls purchased to use for practice are used at that particular time. We cannot afford to have balls mothballed in players bags or carts. Only purchase what you intend to use. We have options of 25 / 50 / 100 ball buckets at very reasonable prices. Calls to our suppliers have resulted in being told that balls will not be available until early 2023. Please if you have balls in your bag/cart please return them to the bar so we can make them available to people.

### **Pennants 2023**

We have placed nominations for both Division 2 and Division 5 pennants competition for 2023. Div 2 will be jointly coordinated by Craig Brennan and Jack Ehrlich. Div 5 will be led by Peter Francis. Thank you to these guys for stepping up to see us continue as a force in representative golf. We have a good base of players to select strong teams, keep your eyes open to further news in 2023.

### **Ball Register**

Members are reminded that all players receive a \$3 credit to the ball register for any pin shots or rundown balls won during a competition round. This credit is recorded and available to use for purchases from the pro shop, range balls or special order items. Balances are unable to be used for bar purchases or competition fees. Our next project will be to extend the concrete path to the 14th tee and also a new path from the bbq area towards the 1st fairway extending approx 15 metres and a width of 3 metres. After this is done we will look to further improve areas around the club / course which are not of a high priority. We ask that members might consider donating their bottles and cans if they do not wish to cash them themselves. 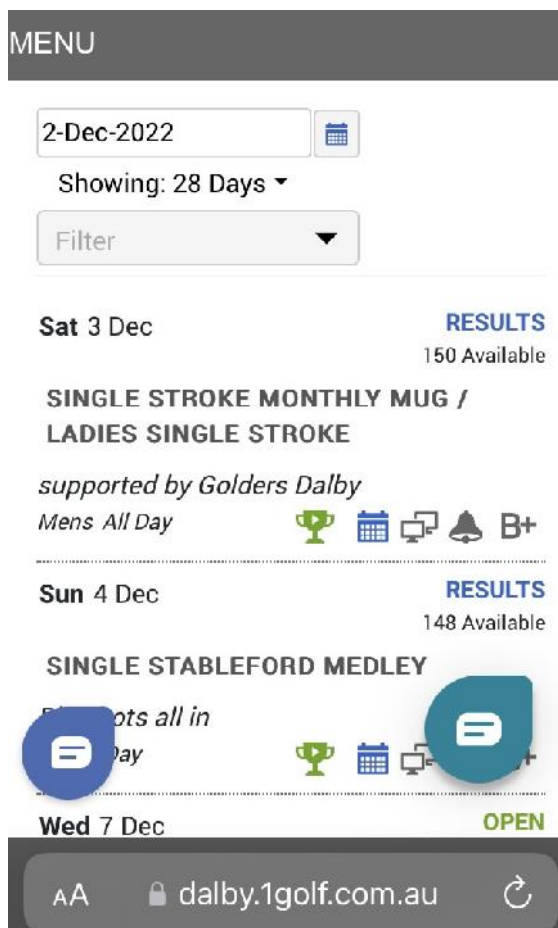

\*This is our last Weekly Golf News for 2022 and we'll resume in the new year with a full calendar of events.

In 2023, we have some changes to the way results are published...

- 1) We are moving the publishing of Daily Competition Results completely to the MiClub online platform which will appear under the "Bookings" tab.
- 2) MiClub generates the Full Field Results automatically at the end of each day's play. You can then view the event leaderboard anytime under "RESULTS".
- 3) Over the Xmas break it would be useful for members to discover how to view these results both on their phones and desktop devices, as it will no longer appear in the weekly news.

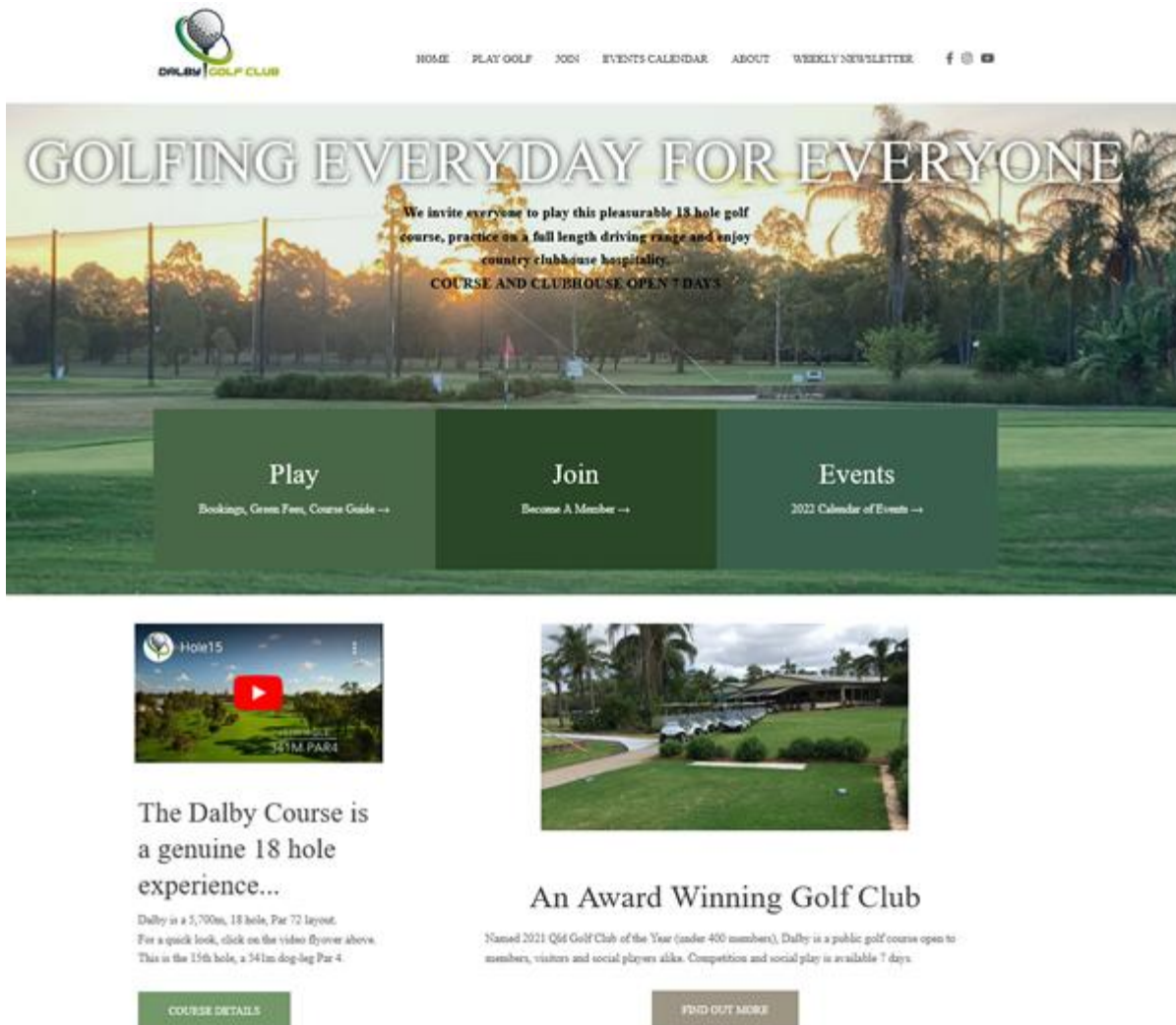

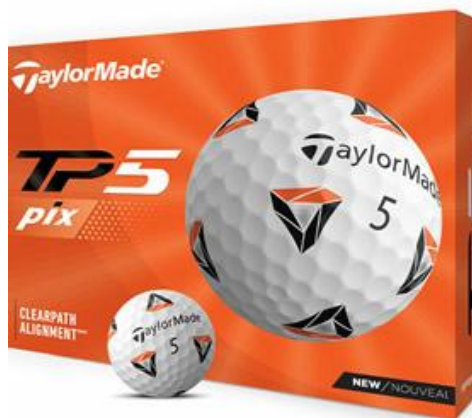

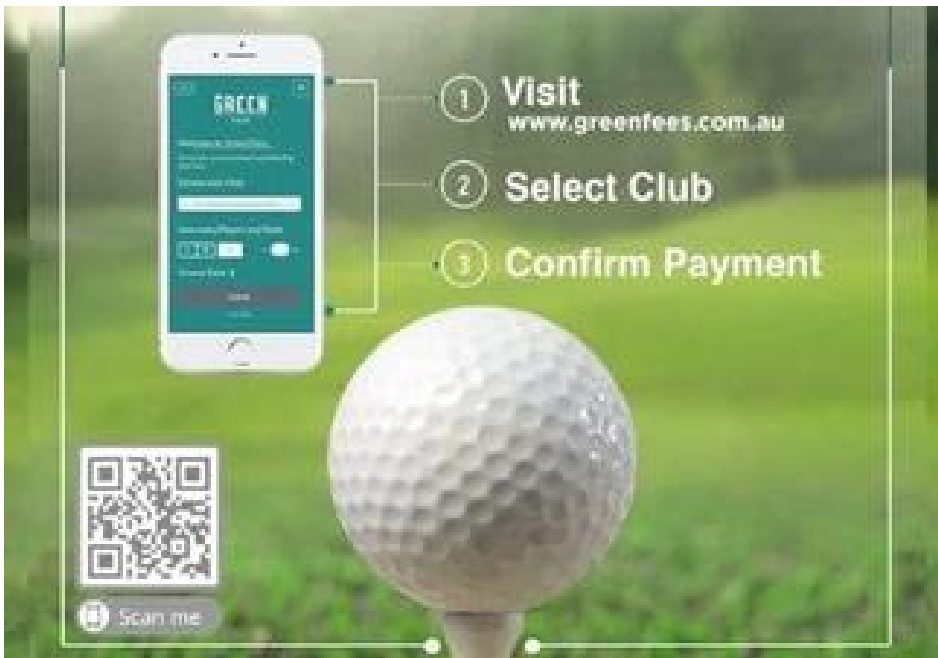
